

Health & Safety

LGM remains committed to non-negotiable product and workplace safety. As a permanent and priority agenda item at all operational meetings, safety comes first in our company. Our products are engineered for safe operation, and we initiate and maintain a safe workplace.

Chemicals are only allowed to be used in accordance to Safety Data Sheet, and are kept in appropriate Cabinet for Chemicals at LGM premises when not in use.

LGM invest in our safety culture and in elevating the importance of worker and product safety throughout all levels of the organization:

1. Reported incidents and accidents are reviewed by Management on a daily basis, necessary measures are taken promptly.
2. Monthly, Management conducts a safety round, inspecting personal protective equipment, machine safety, workplace ergonomics and fire protection.
3. Every quarter, Management conducts a review of operations, including safety and other risk factors. Safety is also included as a topic in Management monthly updates.
4. Annually, the Board is presented with a progress report on safety. Every LGM associate is held accountable for ensuring safe behaviors and safe operations.

To be prepared of Emergency following points shall be followed by any LGM employee or associate:

1. Stay informed. Knowing about the hazards that may strike your community and the risks you may have to take could be lifesaving. Learn about emergency and weather alert systems.
2. Learn about basic injury and disease prevention. You can find information on MSB site on the Internet or from your health care provider.
3. Look for the most current information on emergency preparedness. MSB provides print materials, conferences and information on their web site to help people prepare for emergencies.
4. Become familiar with the emergency plans of your community, school besides the LGM workplace. Make copies of the plans and keep them in a safe place to review and refer to if emergencies occur.
